

# REVERSE FRUIT MENU





**Reversed Fruit** contains organic materials which will perish **if not preserved**.  
Preservation options provided by the artist include:  
1. Items are suspended in a jar of **sterile solution** (images on final page)  
2. Items are encased in a **layer of resin**, resulting in a gloss, waxy finish  
Both options will render items **stable** and **permanent**.

Alternatively, items can be preserved **semi-permanently** if stored/displayed in a **refrigerated environment**.  
Notes on approximate rates of decay (when unrefrigerated) are included in Price List

8. Flower bunch**	600	500	Will not decay
9. Bread loaf	900	800	Will not decay

\*Price listed for bananas pertains to individual bananas. If desired as a bunch, each additional banana will be priced at 75% of the original price.

\*\* Flower prices are negotiable based on the number of individual flowers the bouquet. Availability of certain flowers is seasonal. Please enquire into *Fleurs du Jour* menu.

Flowers and bread are able to be treated in the making process to not be vulnerable to decay. Jar/resin options available as an aesthetic preference. Neither requires refrigeration.
